



ANTIDUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING DUTY ORDERS ON ALUMINUM EXTRUSIONS FROM CHINA

- **The scope of the antidumping and countervailing duty orders on aluminum extrusions from China is broad.**
 - Basic extruded profiles are covered by the orders as well as aluminum extrusions with a variety of finishes and types of fabrication, with limited exceptions.
 - The scope of these orders also covers aluminum extrusions that may be described as parts for final finished products that are assembled after importation.
 - The aluminum extrusion components that are attached to other aluminum extrusion components, non-aluminum extrusion components, or some combination thereof, to form subassemblies, *i.e.*, partially assembled merchandise, may also be subject to duties.
- **Importers are responsible for properly declaring entries of products that are subject to antidumping/countervailing duties.** Failure to properly declare merchandise as subject to antidumping and/or countervailing duty orders may result in penalties.
- **The current antidumping and countervailing duty rates:**
 - The **AD rate** applicable to most Chinese producers/exporters of aluminum extrusions should fall in the range of 32.79 percent to 86.01 percent.
 - The **CVD rate** applicable to most Chinese producers/exporters of aluminum extrusions should fall in the range of 7.37 percent to 216.61 percent.
 - **Antidumping and countervailing duty rates are additive.** The applicable duties are added together.
- **Section 232 duties may also apply to certain imports of aluminum extrusions.**
 - Section 232 duties would apply to products that fall into the category of pure lineal profiles, such as those classified under Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS) heading 7604. Fabricated aluminum extrusions that are classified under HTS heading 7610 would not be subject to Section 232 duties. However, these types of products would likely be subject to antidumping/countervailing duties.
